## RULES FOR PODCAST COMPETITION - 2019

Dear student and supervisor

Please familiarize yourself with the following basic rules for the PODCAST competition. The theme for the competition is:

*“Managing the ecological footprint of livestock through efficient production”*

Participants are requested to address the following three main aspects in their PODCAST recording:

1. Defining the ecological footprint of livestock
2. What are the ecological challenges for future generations of Animal Scientists
3. How could we improve production efficiency in a challenging environment

Rules:

- Only under-graduate students are allowed to enter for the PODCAST competition is.
- Participants should present an un-biased and scientifically based opinion on the relative topics.
- All participants must complete the registration form provided and should be signed off by a supervisor.
- All recordings should be approved by a representative lecturer at the specific tertiary institute who will act as the supervisor before submission to the competition.
- All participants must be registered final year students at a recognised tertiary institute within South Africa.
- Individual and/or group (maximum 4 members/group) registrations are accepted.
- All recordings and editing of the PODCAST must be done by the participating students.
- Participants are not allowed to use professional audio-visual service providers.
- The maximum duration of the PODCAST recording is 5 minutes.
